## ROTATION/PORTFOLIO RUBRIC "creating your own learning and pushing it further"

You and your partner are going to work together to create a project that best shows your understanding of the material that you have selected to work with. During this time, you will work on creating objectives that showcase what you hope to create during the engagement time frame by using the slides on group portfolio. As you create and work on your project you will work through Learning Launchers that will help you to create a personal portfolio of understanding. Your personal portfolio NEEDS to show 5 different aspects of what you learned during the engagement time frame. As you finish the project you and your partner will each take 3 of your personal portfolio items and add them to your group portfolio. The group portfolio will also include your exploration of the equipment and/or programs that you will use for your final project. You will also add to your group portfolio your conclusions and assessment of your objectives and determine if your project was, in fact, successful or not (if not explain what happened and how you might change this if you do this engagement again).

#### WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW TO BE SUCCESSFUL:

Use the following checklist to help you determine what you need to be included in your portfolio.

### Purpose/Question -

- Title Slide filled out
- At least 1 described problem when first using the hardware/software
- At least 1 solution/suggestion for the first encountered problem
- Hypothesis that meets the listed criteria for a SMART goal:
  - o **Specific**: objective states directly what you intend to achieve
  - Measurable: able to directly tell the success of the project by your end product
  - o Attainable: must be realistically achievable with the time and resources provided
  - o Relevant: must be important to both you and material
  - o **Time-Based**: must be accomplished by the end of the rotation
  - o Resulting If/Then Statement: must be based on information from your SMART Goal
- At least 5 ePortfolio suggestions have been filled out

### Experiment – (individual portfolio)

**Hypothesis** –

- At least 3 suggestions contain **original** illustrations/images that explain what is being described
- At least 1 suggestion has an **original** movie either created by you or researched online by you
- Must contain descriptive words that allow any reader to better understand your project and content.
  - 2 Slides MUST contain RESEARCH based on your engagement or concepts dealing with your engagement (MUST be original research on each slide and different from group members)
  - o 3 Slides MUST be based on your engagement and what you were able to accomplish during your time working on the engagement
- Contains at least 6 ePortfolio suggestions

### Analysis – (group portfolio)

- o 3 from each member of the group At least 3 suggestions contain illustrations/images that explain what is being described
- At least 1 suggestion has a movie either created by you or researched online by you
- Must contain descriptive words that allow any reader to better understand your project and content.
- Must contain a description of if you met/didn't meet your hypothesis stated at the start of the project

# Conclusion – (located on group portfolio)

- At least 2 images of your successes or setbacks
- Description of best and hardest part of your chosen project
- Predictions/suggestions on if you were to redo this project what changes you would do

#### Remember

Each person needs to fill out their individual portfolio before going on to the group portfolio

Each portfolio **NEEDS** to contain images and movies that describe your learning/project. Remember images and movies can sometimes better describe your project better than words.
