WEBwareness **“Being aware of all the spiders on the WEB”**

During the summer team meetings, it was brought up to the 7th grade team, by various parents and school administration that the Internet is a dangerous place and should not be allowed at school. After a unanimous vote it has been decided that students will not be put in danger by having access to the Internet. The parents and 7th grade team believe that the Internet is nothing more than an unsafe playground. After much pleading for the students by Mr. Riordan, the parents and 7th grade team have agreed to meet again for a final vote. Will the Internet be banned forever? Or can you, the students, change their minds?

You will need to prove to the parents and 7th grade team that you understand how to be safe on the Internet and you will only have one chance to make this pledge. To accomplish this goal, you and your team will each choose a different role and gather information about four different aspects of the Internet. You must become an expert in your area so that you are able to persuade your parents to vote in favor of allowing the Internet back in the classroom. As an expert you will voice your thoughts on an online message board that proves you know how to use the Internet correctly. You must also compile a list of the “Top 10” rules for staying safe on the Internet that will be displayed at school in the halls and during important events.

 - Answer each of the questions for your role in **complete sentences!**
 - As you are researching start to compile a list of “Top 10” Internet Safety tips (write your ideas on the back of your worksheet)
 - After you have finished your questions share your answers with **OTHER** members from **DIFFERENT** groups that have the same role. (**each member should sign your paper after you have shared answers**)

 - Post 1 comments on the slide of your role about what you learned in your research
 - 1 Post for all other roles

 - Create with your group a poster that is appealing to the eye
 - Make sure the poster contains **10 different rules** for being safe (each member of the group should contribute 2-3 ideas)
