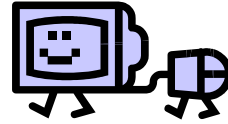
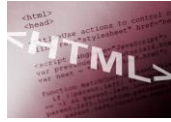

## Codecademy “knowing the code to get into it all”



You are going to learn some basic web coding that will give you a look at what goes into making all of the websites that you enjoy. During your time at the CODECADEMY will participate in 3 different mini-courses that will introduce you to the world of coding. Each of the mini-courses will help you create something that will be put on your own website at the end of the term. After you have completed all of mini-courses then you will sign up for 1 of the in-depth coding courses, where you will learn how to create some fantastic codes (such as online games or interactive graphics)

### WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW TO BE SUCCESSFUL:

Use the following checklist to help you determine what you need to do to complete the codecademy

At each of the different points in the course you will need to copy your code and paste it into your codecademy worksheet:

Bubble Name Code -

- When you are on slide 4/15
- When you are on slide 8/15
- When you are on slide 12/15
- When you have completed 15/15 (or the whole code)

At each of the different points in the course you will need to copy your code and paste it into your codecademy worksheet:

Sun, Earth, Code -

- When you are on slide 2/7
- When you are on slide 4/7
- When you are on slide 6/7
- When you have completed 7/7 (or the whole code)

At each of the different points in the course you will need to copy your code and paste it into your codecademy worksheet:

About You Code -

- When you are on slide 5/21
- When you are on slide 10/21
- When you are on slide 16/21
- When you have completed 21/21 (or the whole code)

At each of the different points in the course you will need to copy your code and paste it into your codecademy worksheet:

Codecademy Advanced Course -

- When you are 25% complete
- When you are 50% complete
- When you are 75% complete
- When you have completed 100% (or the whole code)

For each section important vocabulary has been written down including definitions to better help you to understand concepts presented throughout each activity.

Codecademy Terminology:

- Each section should have 3 words/concept written down
- Each word should have a definition or explanation to better help understand
- Example lines of code need to be provided for each term
- At least 12 words should be included on the worksheet.

**REMEMBER:** When you are copying your code for completion make sure you highlight the difference in your code from the previous section. So when you are going from 25% to 50% highlight everything that is different from the previous code to show you have changed something.
